

EFFINGHAM COUNTY HIGHWAY PERMIT

WHEREAS, I (We) _____, _____
(Name of Applicant) (Mailing Address & Phone Number)

Hereinafter termed the Applicant, request permission and authority to do certain work herein described on the right-of-way of the County Highway known as _____ Route_____, Section_____, from Station _____ to Station_____, Effingham County. The work is described in detail on the attached sketch and/or as follows:_____

The applicant shall be responsible for all damages and assume all liabilities for construction, location, operation and maintenance of said utility.

A copy of this permit shall be in the possession of the Construction Foreman on the job site for inspection by county highway personnel.

Right-of way (R.O.W.): It is the applicant's responsibility to establish the correct property line. This permit only grants applicant permission and authority to do certain work herein described on the R.O.W. of County highways. This permit does not authorize work within township R.O.W.

It is understood that the work authorized by this permit shall be completed within 6 months after the date this permit is approved; otherwise the permit becomes null and void.

All surfaces, if necessary, shall be restored to original condition according to I.D.O.T. Road and Bridge current addition specifications. The proposed work shall be located and constructed to the satisfaction of the County Engineer or his duly authorized representative. No open trenches immediately adjacent to pavement are allowed to be left open overnight.

The applicant shall at all times conduct the work in such a manner to minimize hazards to vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Traffic controls and work site protection shall be in accordance with the applicable requirements of chapter 6 (Traffic Controls for Highway Construction and Maintenance Operations) of the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways. Work shall be done only during daylight hours.

No excavation within 5 feet of roadway surface will be permitted. Lines shall be buried at least 24 inches below existing ground line and within 5 feet from edge of R.O.W where practicable. Lines below roadway shall be bored at a depth no less than 24 inches below the ditch flow line elevation.

If future construction and/or maintenance performed by the County require the relocation of the utility, it shall be done at the applicant's expense within 30 days of written notification.

Effingham County is not liable for any damage to any utility if the County is doing work within R.O.W.
